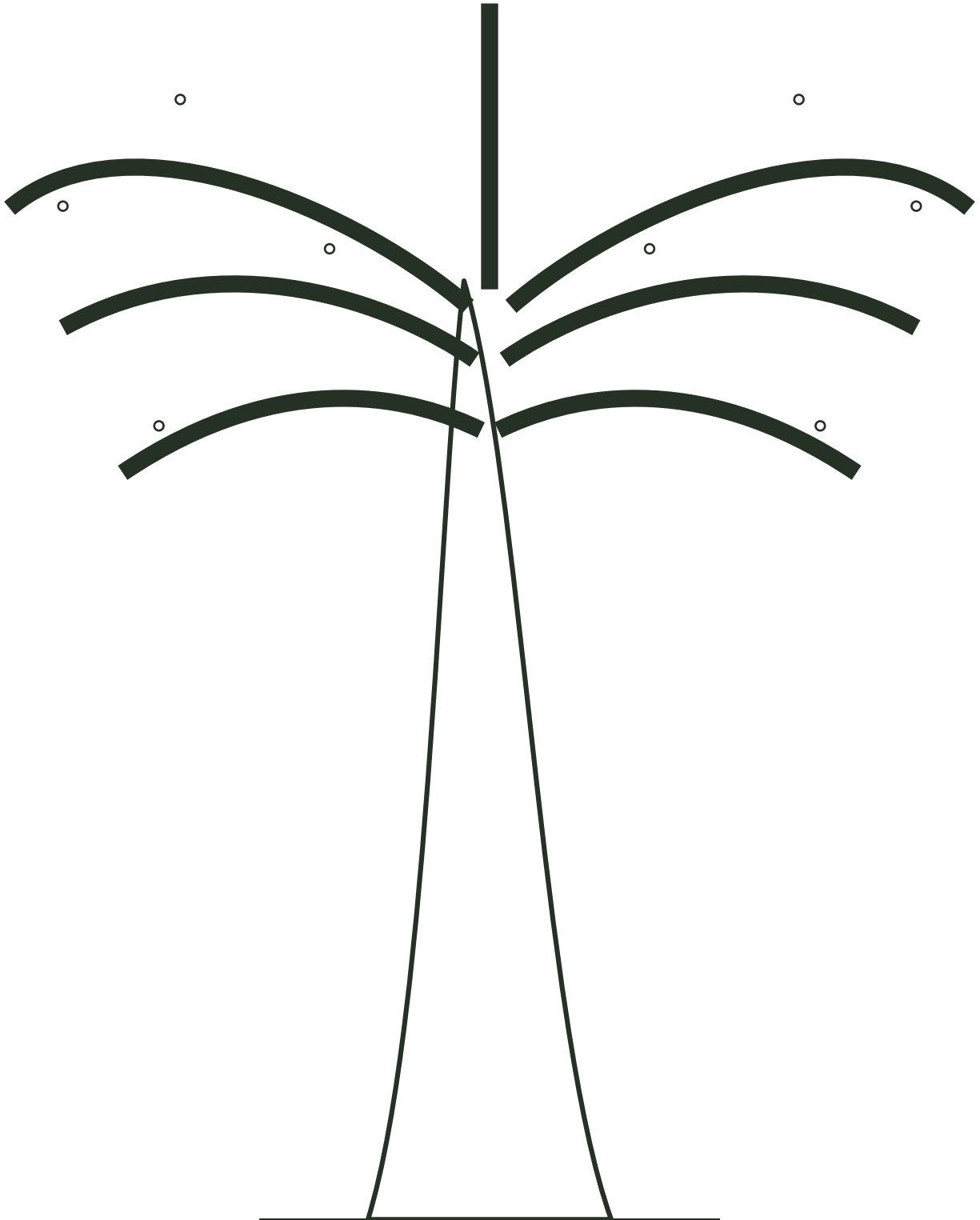


Build Your Thankful Tree

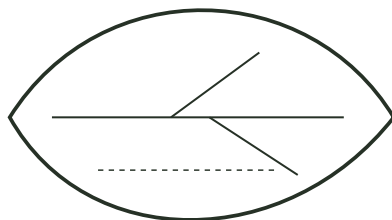
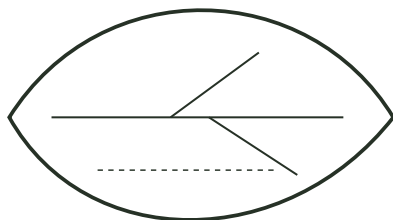
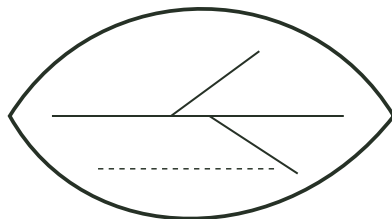
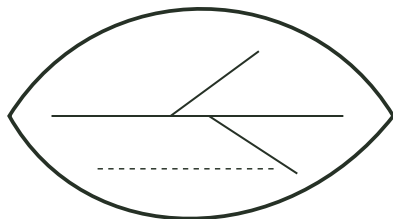
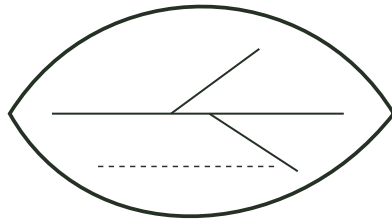
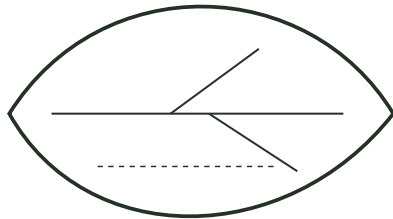
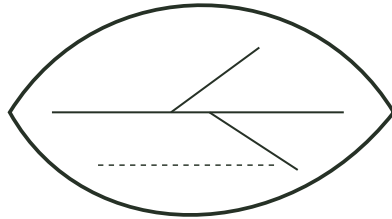
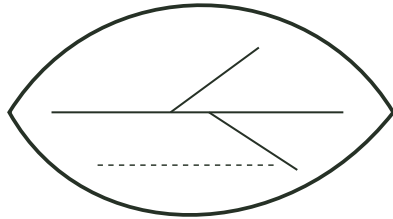
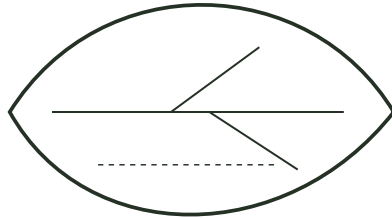
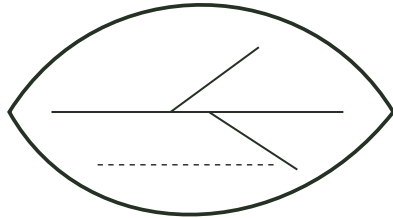
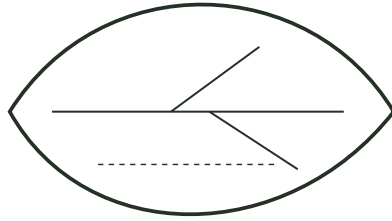
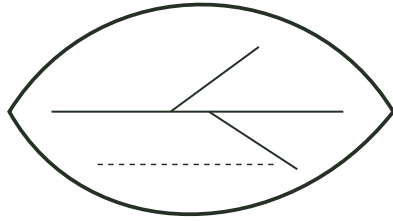
Write or draw on the leaves, cut them out, and attach them to the branches.



Small dots suggest attachment spots; use any arrangement that fits your group.

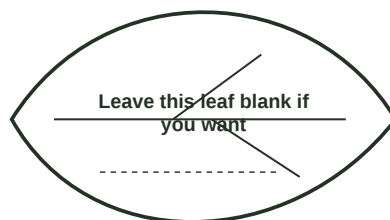
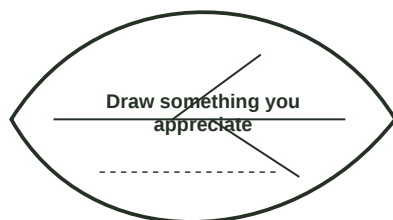
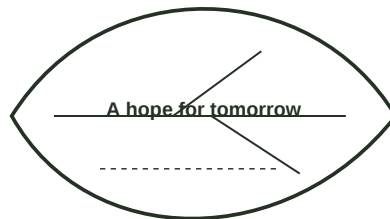
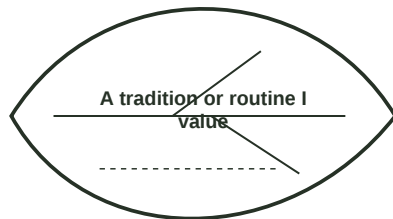
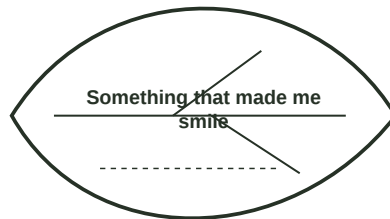
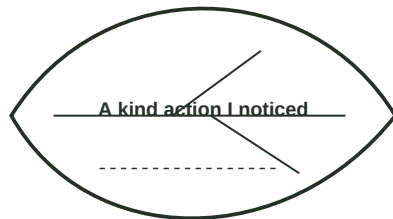
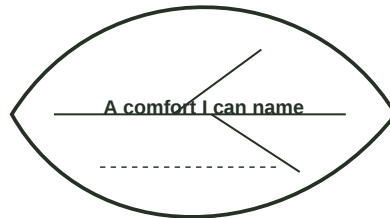
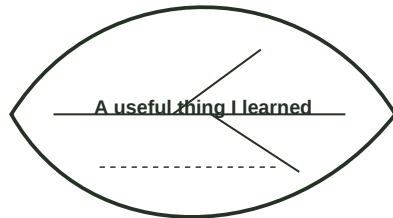
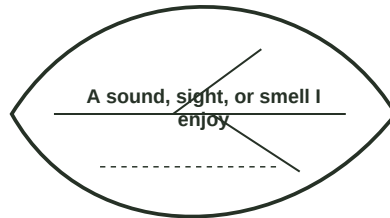
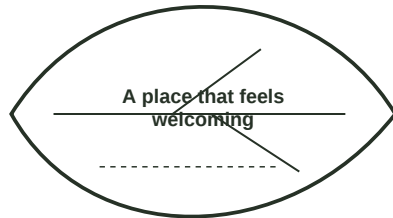
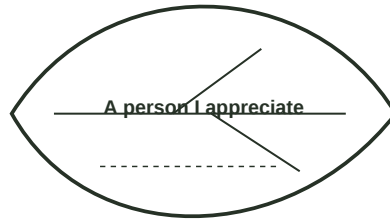
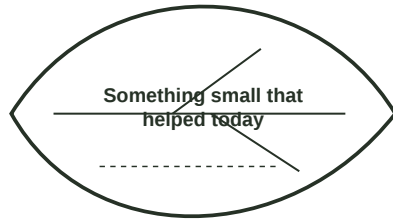
Blank Thankful Leaves

Simple Assembly Instructions

Choose only the pages and prompts that feel useful for your group.

1

Print

Print the tree and either leaf sheet at 100% / Actual Size. Do not use Fit to Page.

2

Write or draw

Add a word, short note, or drawing. Prompts are optional; blank leaves are equally welcome.

3

Cut

Cut around each leaf outline. An adult should supervise or complete cutting for children.

4

Attach

Use small pieces of tape or glue to place leaves on the branches. Start near the trunk and work outward.

5

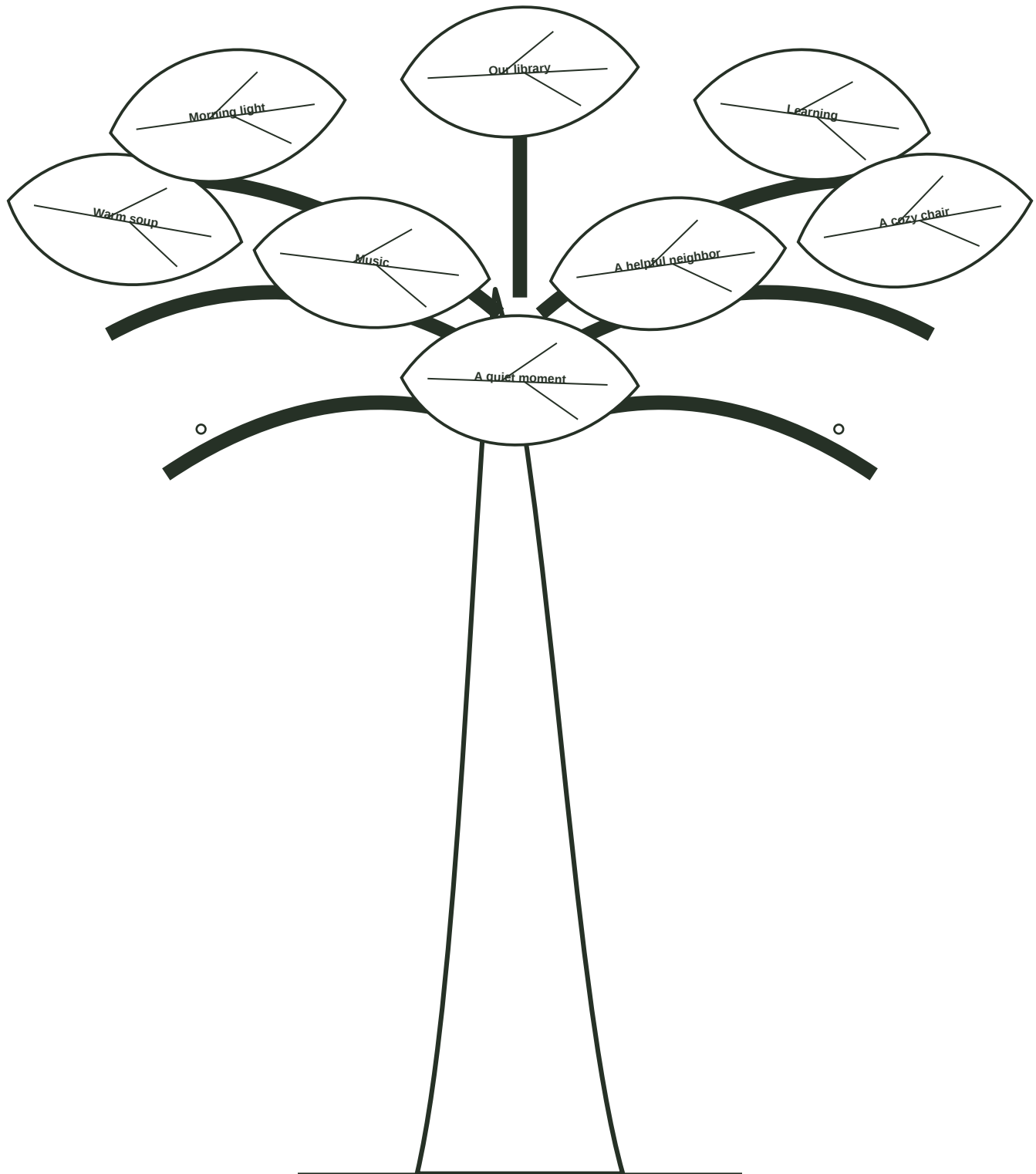
Display

Post the finished tree on a wall, door, bulletin board, or refrigerator. Add leaves over time if desired.

Tip: Print extra leaf pages when more people want to participate.

Assembled Thankful Tree

The leaves below use the same 2 x 1.25 inch cut shape as the printable sheets.



Verified fit: eight same-proportion leaves remain inside the printable area as shown.
