Subject: Pigs Eye ban and Event April 11th

Message: I'm writing to share a concern about an event that took place on April 11 at Pig's Eye Regional Park. I would prefer to remain anonymous, as my intention is not to create conflict, but simply to bring something forward that I believe needs to be reviewed. Josh is currently banned from St. Paul parks due to prior conduct (good call), including a recent incident on April 11. Despite that, he was still involved in this event through close association. The event was organized by James Collins Jr., who operates a local nonprofit called Where Purpose Is Found. What is most concerning to me is the clear and ongoing connection between Josh and James. They work closely together, and this did not appear to be separate from that relationship. It raises serious concern that even with Josh being banned, he is still able to remain involved in park activities indirectly through James and others acting on his behalf. I have attached a video from that day, along with an image showing Josh's cameraman present at the event. The setup included loudspeakers, a full sound system, a stage, and what appeared to be a concert-style gathering, which leads me to question whether proper permits were obtained. I want to be clear that there are many ministries and outreach groups that serve in that area regularly, and they do so with genuine care, respect, and the right intentions for the people they are supporting. That's part of why this situation stood out. I also have concerns regarding how impact is being represented publicly under this nonprofit. There are statements being made claiming that over 15,000 people have been fed and clothed. Based on what I have personally seen and experienced, those claims are not accurate and raise serious concerns. Additionally, I have seen photos and videos of individuals from encampments across different cities (including Maple Grove and Cambridge) being posted while tagging Pig's Eye Regional Park as the location. Sharing images of vulnerable individuals while tying them to a specific encampment location raises real safety concerns. In my opinion, this kind of exposure puts people at risk and does not respect their privacy or dignity. Overall, it is the combination of the relationship between Josh and James, the nature of this event, and the way content is being shared publicly that prompted me to reach out. I respectfully ask that this situation be reviewed, including whether proper permits were obtained and whether existing park restrictions are being upheld. I'm not looking to be involved beyond sharing this information. I just felt it was important to pass this along so it can be looked into if needed.
